Passes easily through a standard door and has lockable wheels for ease of positioning. Prints from 4" x 6" (10x15cm) up to a full 12" x 18" (30x46cm) are possible. Produces consumer prints, added value gifts and promotions and professional formats all on one compact printer! Easy to use with *Plug-n-Print™* - slot insertion replenisher cartridges, as simple to change as inkjet! *DigeMix™* - automatically mixes replenisher to the correct concentration. *Print Q Manager™* - simple trough intuitive touch screen operation. Easy load 6" (15cm), 7" (18cm) and 8" (20cm) paper cassettes for standard consumer print sizes and universal 12" (30cm) cassette for larger formats up to 12" x 18" (30x46cm).
