O-ring seals protect them against rain and sea spray and they can be submerged in up to 3 feet of water for five minutes. The optics are nitrogen-filled to minimize fogging which can occur with sudden temperature changes.

These new Minolta Activa WP Sport binoculars provide bright images and comfortable viewing. Long eye relief allows even eyeglass wearers to see the entire field of view without vignetting. The binoculars use high-refraction BaK4 prisms and multi-coated optics to deliver bright, high-contrast images.

The Activa WP Sport binoculars incorporate several user-friendly features. Twisting eyepiece cups make adjusting the binoculars for people with and without glasses simple, and click stops prevent the cups from moving. The diopter adjustment also uses click stops to keep the setting from drifting once set. The oversized focusing knob is designed for easy operation. The new rubberized grip provides a non-slip surface in rain or sub-freezing temperatures.
